Course Description:

This discussion will describe basic concepts of the Postural Restoration Institute and give practical applications for physical and occupational therapists to integrate breathing assessment and treatment into any rehabilitation program.

Individuals attending this course will be able to identify and recognize dominant patterns of breathing and how they contribute to common types of musculoskeletal, neurological and/or respiratory pathology. We will discuss how the spine's movement is dependent on ribcage, pelvis and cranial position and how we can influence change through exercise and behavior modification. Additionally, this course will discuss specific mechanisms on how elevated stress and anxiety can contribute to posture and pain (and vice versa).

Program Objectives:

- Identify basic concepts of the Postural Restoration Institute and how this may differ from traditional approaches to rehabilitation
- Discover how to assess breathing using objective measurements utilized by the Postural Restoration Institute
- Describe the implications of breathing dysfunction and how it may be contributing to commonly treated pathologies and syndromes
- Introduce basic exercises and manual techniques designed to counter and correct common breathing patterns

Speaker Bio:



Alex graduated with a BS in kinesiology from Western Washington University in 2009 and a DPT in physical therapy from Regis University in 2013. In 2015 he opened Root & Branch Physical Therapy, which specializes in treating individuals with chronic and complex pain patterns. Over the past six years he has attended 328 hours of continuing education courses, most of which were offered through the Postural Restoration Institute. In 2019 he was named Top Physical Therapist in Portland, as voted by his peers in Portland

Monthly Magazine's annual wellness issue. Alex's keys to success are patient education, engagement and empowerment through active listening, evidence-based practice and multidisciplinary integration.
